Camille co-founded #ShareTheMicInCyber and has been honored by Business Insider (AI 100) and Microsoft (Security Changemaker of the Year). She holds a JD from American University, a CISO certificate from Carnegie Mellon, and CISSP and PMP credentials. Camille currently leads efforts in AI governance and digital resilience.
